

BY-LAWS OF THE GARDEN

Please take care. All persons enter the garden at their own risk and the Committee shall not be held responsible for any accidents.

Admission to this garden is by key, available to residents from the Secretary of the Leinster Square Gardens Association. The Committee will withdraw the right to use the garden from any keyholder who persistently disregards the by-laws given here.

The overriding principle to guide those using this garden is that no keyholder or guest should behave in such a way as to spoil the enjoyment of others. In addition, the following by-laws should be adhered to:

- Please do not engage in any behaviour that may be offensive or disturbing to other users of the garden or to residents of the square.
- Keep the gates closed and locked at all times.
- Dogs are not allowed into the garden.
- All games that involve balls or throwing, hitting or kicking things are prohibited.
- Members may invite a maximum of 15 guests into the garden at one time. Larger private parties will only be allowed at the express discretion of the Committee. If you wish to apply for permission to hold such a party, please contact The Secretary.
- Please do not pick the flowers or damage the lawns, plants, trees, railings or other fixtures.
- Please do not make unreasonable levels of noise. Radios and other amplified sound equipment are not permitted.
- Please use the litter bins provided and do not leave rubbish in the garden. Members are responsible for clearing up after themselves and their guests.
- The garden must be vacated at dusk. Overnight sleeping is not permitted.
- Small barbeques are permitted on the paths. Please do not use barbeque equipment under the trees, on the grass, or on the wooden benches.
