

LEINSTER SQUARE GARDEN BYE-LAWS

We ask all garden users to show consideration and respect for nature, the garden, other users and local residents.

Specifically, you must abide by these bye-laws. Any keyholder who persistently disregards the bye-laws will forfeit their access to the garden.

- Do not pick the flowers or other plants.
- Take care to avoid causing any damage to the lawns, plants, trees, paths, railings, benches or other garden furniture.
- Please be especially careful when BBQ'ing. Disposable BBQs get very hot so we encourage you to use the slate tables as these are heat resistant.
- Do not fix ropes to the trees or garden furniture or otherwise use them as gym equipment.
- No ball games, or any other games involving throwing, hitting or kicking things.
- No cycling.
- No dogs.
- Do not engage in any behaviour that would disturb other garden users or local residents.
- No radios, microphones or other amplified sound equipment.
- No flying of drones.
- Do not leave any rubbish or personal belongings in the garden.
- Parties of more than 15 guests require permission in advance, and a small fee is payable.
- The garden is open from dawn to dusk. Overnight sleeping is not permitted.
- Securely close the gate as you enter and exit. Keep yourselves and other members safe.
- **Children must be supervised at all times.**

Please take care in the garden. All persons enter at their own risk and the Committee shall not be held responsible for any accidents.
